08 Historic York and York Olive Oil Company NEW TOUR \$45 9.00am–4.00pm

York is one of the most beautifully restored towns in Australia. It is West Australia's first inland town, steeped with history and worldly charm. This tour gives you an opportunity to spend more time exploring some of the many historic buildings and attractions that York has to offer. It also explores the important part, York played with the early settlers. You will have a chance to admire the lovely park on the banks of the Avon River where you can simply bring a picnic lunch or indulge in one of the many café's and pubs in town. The choice is yours. We call into the York Olive Farm on the way home to taste their famous ice-creams and olive oil products before slowly making our way home. Lunch can be arranged at the Settlers tearooms or Castle Hotel \$70.

09 Avon Valley Explorer. York, Northam and Toodyay NEW TOUR \$69 9.00am–4.00pm

We make our way to York, pausing along the way for our picnic morning tea. On arrival in York you will have some free time to have a look around this beautifully restored town.
