

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**Day 1. Perth – Kalbarri.** All aboard for 7 days of discovery and excitement. We make our way north to Gin Gin for our morning tea before continuing on via the Brand Hwy to Eneabba where you will have some free time to buy yourself some lunch before continuing our journey via Dongara, Geraldton, Northampton and the amazing Pink Lakes before ultimately arriving in Kalbarri for the next two nights. **Palm Resort DBB. Please note not licenced. BYO only from bottle shop next door.**

**Day 2. Kalbarri.** After breakfast at the Palms Resort we board the coach at 8.30am to view the Pelican feeding on the foreshore. Time now to go and explore some of the coastal gorges and morning tea at a scenic location. Back into town for some free time to purchase some lunch before visiting the Rainbow Jungle with its impressive collection of native birds. Back to your motel for some free time before our evening meal. **Palm Resort DBB**

**Day 3. Kalbarri - Denham .** We depart Kalbarri at 8.30am and head to the see the magnificent Skywalk over looking the mighty Murchison River. Our journey now continues north towards Denham in the World Heritage listed area of Shark Bay where we will spend the next two nights at the Heritage Resort. We will pause for an opportunity to buy some lunch along the way at the Billabong Roadhouse before continuing onto Denham and checking out some sights along the way including Shell Beach and the Eagle Bluff Lookout before arriving at our accommodation for the next two nights at the **Heritage Resort. DBB**

**Day 4. Denham, Monkey Mia.** An early start of 7.30am to see the feeding of the magnificent Dolphins at Monkey Mia Resort. Some free time after to maybe have a swim or grab a coffee before a fabulous 3 hour cruise on the Aristocat which returns at 10'clock so we will provide a light packed lunch for you to take on board. Free time in the afternoon to relax, swim or just chat with your fellow travellers over a nice coffee or tea before boarding the coach back to Denham where we will visit the fabulous Shark Bay World Heritage Discovery and Interpretive Centre and watch a short movie "HMAS Sydney11 (Fire on the Water) Back to the Heritage for another 3 course dinner and a well earned rest. **Heritage Resort. DBB**

**Day 5. Denham to Geraldton.** We depart the motel at 8,00am and make our way to the ancient Hamelin Pool Stromatolites. Free time to view and we will also have our morning tea here. Our journey continues towards Geraldton with a stop at Billabong for a break and a chance to get some lunch before continuing on to Northampton and ultimately our accommodation for the next two nights at the **Hospitality Inn DBB.**

**Day 6. Wildflower Day.** We depart the motel at 8.30am. We now head into wildflower country and towards the township of Mullewa for our morning tea, before heading to Pindar. This area is famous for the Wreath Flower which is a member of the Leschenaultia family. We make our way to the Coal Seam Conservation Park which is famous for its carpets of yellow everlastings and unique landscape. Here we will supply a light picnic lunch After some free time to explore we will be making our way back to Geraldton. **Hospitality Inn DBB.**

**Day 7. Geraldton - Perth.** Sadly it is time to leave our hosts here in Geraldton and start on our return journey towards Perth. We travel via Three Springs where we stop for morning tea, Continuing onto Western Wildflower Farm where we will enjoy a light lunch and an informative talk and video on this industry. Our journey continues through to Bindoon for a brief stop before continuing onto Perth.
