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## *3 Day Midwest Wildflower Tour*

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**Day 1.** We make our way north to Yanchep National Park where we will stop for morning tea. After morning tea our journey continues north via. Our journey continues along the Indian Ocean Drive and fishing villages of Lancelin, Green Head, Lee-man and Port Denison and Dongara. We pause in Jurien Bay where we will enjoy a light lunch before continuing to Green Head with some free time to have a look around and explore this magnificent coastline. After a full day we arrive in Geraldton and our accommodation for the next 2 nights the **Ibis Motel DBB**.

**Day 2.** After a hearty breakfast we hit the road with a picnic lunch loaded and start exploring the area. We now head into wildflower country and towards the township of Mullewa and onto Pindar. This area is famous for the Wreath Flower which is a member of the Leschenaultia family and is very impressive and is quite rare. Its certainly outback travelling as we travel along gravel roads in search of wildflowers and make our way to the Coal Seam Conservation Park which is famous for its carpets of yellow everlasting and unique landscape. This is the sight of the first discovery of coal in Western Australia and an excellent spot to explore the rugged beauty of the area before making our way back to Geraldton. On our return we will visit the very impressive Sydney Memorial overlooking the city and the Indian Ocean. **Ibis Motel DBB**

**Day 3.** Sadly it is time to leave our hosts here in Geraldton and start on our return journey towards Perth. We travel via Three Springs, Carnamah and Moora as we make our way to the Coomberdale Wildflower Farm where we will enjoy a light lunch and presentation of the dried wildflower industry. Our journey continues through the Victoria Plains area and the scenic Chittering Valley before continuing onto Perth.
